The Ozark Chapter of the Missouri Society of Professional Surveyors is a professional society whose membership is made up of active professional land sur, retired professional land surveyors, and associates who work in mapping, engineering, and other related fields. The Ozark Chapter has been chartered since 1957 and is dedicated to the betterment of surveying as a profession.

The Chapter offers this scholarship to benefit students of land surveying who are currently working in the land surveying profession and are enrolled in a "Survey" specific course at any of the schools utilizing approved classroom work or approved on-line curriculum for future licensure as a Professional Land Surveyor in the State of Missouri. It is also suggested that the recipient be a member of good standing within the Ozark Chapter and residing/working within the geographical limits of the Ozark Chapter. See attached list of approved coursework either in-class or on-line as currently set forth.

The size of the scholarship, and the number of scholarships offered each year, varies depending on funds available and is determined by a vote of Chapter members.

General Regulations and Procedures

1. Scholarships may be awarded annually based on the recommendation of the scholarship committee, and a voting of the membership at scheduled meetings.
2. Applicants should currently be enrolled in one of the courses currently approved.
3. Applicants will have maintained a minimum of a "B" grade average in any courses that they may have previously completed.
4. Financial need will be one of the criteria in the selection of scholarship recipients.
5. Current employment by the applicant in surveying or a related field is required.
6. Administration and awarding of these scholarships are through the Ozark Chapter of M.S.P.S., with input from course instructors.
7. The scholarship is non-renewable. Re-application for the scholarship is necessary to be considered each semester. Former recipients of the scholarship will be considered only if there are no suitable non-recipients in the application pool.
8. This gift will be administered without discrimination based on race, color, religion, gender, national origin, ancestry, age, or veteran status.
